Introduction:

On behalf of department of Chemistry we have conducted the feedback from teachers on existing syllabus in view of revising the syllabus according to current need and NEP perspective. Feedback has been collected from senior most faculties from various colleges of Rani Channamma University, Belagavi affiliation.

Method of Collecting opinion:

Following questions were asked and sought their opinion in percentage wise (as 50%, 75 % and more than 75 %) as to what extent the present syllabus has to be to retained in connection with employability needs, life skills, creativity, methods of learning and competitive exams.

The following questions were asked:

Question No 1: According to NEP 2020, what % of syllabus of the existing syllabus should be retained during revision?

Question No 2: What % of the existing curriculum is in tune with emerging global, national trends and relevant to local needs?

Question No 3: Scope of the existing curriculum in imparting different life skills.

Question No 4: What % of the curriculum is relevant and appropriate for gaining selfemployment? Question No 5: What % of the syllabus has scope for students to undergo experimental, blended and participative learning?

Question No 6: Content of the present syllabus is oriented towards innovation and creativity.

Abstract of Feed Back Analysis:

Teacher's opinion is that more that 50% of existing curriculum can be retained and more than 25% of the syllabus to be added. Around fifty percentage of new syllabus has to be added in order to enable our students to meet emerging global, national trends and local needs. New curricular aspects have to bring in to enhance the life skills of student and employability. Teachers strongly feel, much attention has to be given for experiential learning and incepting creativity among the students while framing new curriculum to cope up with NEP perceptive.
