

- (4) Our library is a hoard of books and journals: The general library of our institution is a stockpile for the students and researchers since it has 51,780books along with national, international, peer-reviewed journals, e-books, etc. The Institute provides well-equipped digital library for the students to undertake their studies in a much competitive way.
- (5) Proposals for certificate courses to UGC under National Skills Qualifications Framework [NSQF]: From our institution five Departments (Physics, Chemistry, Computer Science, Commerce and Post Graduate Department of Botany) have been shortlisted under NSQF programme of UGC. Anticipating grants from UGC, we have started courses to teach basics of respective courses
- (6) Knowledge upgrading using academic platforms: Teachers and students are deputed to present papers in conference/workshops /Seminars conducted by other institutions. Faculty members participate as resource person in various academic activities. Financial support is provided by the institution to motivate the faculty to understand the present research scenario and update their knowledge which inspires the students for their higher studies in renowned institutes.
- (7) Mentoring the aspiring institutions to go for NAAC assessment: The institute has organized six workshops under UGC funded PARAMARSH scheme.
- (8) Seminars organized: UGC sponsored and self-financed one day state level student seminars on Make in India- Issues Impacts & Prospects on 22/02/2017 and Role of Students in Quality Enhancement of HEIs on 27/02/2019.
