The KLE Society's vision of rural upliftment through education, its missionary zeal and commitment to the cause got amplified with huge donations offered by Kore Brothers of Ankali in the name of their father, a great Gandhian, Srimant Basavaprabhu Kore. Since its inception in 1969, the college has been a big player in empowering the rural youth and rural women in and around Chikodi.

Our college has been accredited at 'A' Grade with CGPA of 3.26 in the third cycle by NAAC in September 2016 after Peer Team visit on 18<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> August 2016. Now the college has also got recognition as College with Potential for Excellence from UGC New Delhi. Under this scheme college receives assistance of 1.5 crore rupees for overall academic development of the college.

Our college offers UG courses such as BA, BSc, BCom, and also PG course in Commerce and Management. The strength of our college is 1187 of whom 599, i.e. more than 50% are girl students. The staff strength of our college is 62 of whom 22 are ladies and the strength of Non teaching staff is 16. In addition to this we are availing the services of 4 visiting faculty members for M.Com.


